

Welcome Fr Jose Gonzales!

- Join us for a reception to welcome Fr Jose following each weekend Liturgy on July 10 & 11.
- Fr Jose Gonzales has been assigned by Bishop Mike to serve as Parochial Vicar at Risen Christ beginning in July 2010. His first weekend in the parish will be July 10/11. We are fortunate that he will be here. Fr. Jose will be the day to day priest presence for the parish. He brings energy, dedication, enthusiasm, humor, experience and a desire to both learn and to grow personally as a priest.
- Fr Jose was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Boise in June 2008. Since his ordination he has served as Parochial Vicar at Mary Immaculate Parish in St Anthony, Idaho with its four locations in north east Idaho.
- The parish of Mary Immaculate covers a territory equal to the size of the State of Connecticut! His weekend driving circuit covered about 500 miles every weekend, in the best and worst imaginable weather conditions
- Prior to his ordination as a priest, he served his pastoral year as a seminarian in 2005/2006 at Our Lady of the Valley Parish, Caldwell, and completed an assignment that summer at St George Parish, Post Falls. In the summer of 2007, he completed Clinical Pastoral Education training at St Luke Hospital, Boise. He returned to the seminary between 2006-2008, where he completed his studies at Mount Angel Seminary, near Portland Oregon.

Health News - Health Ministry



“For the sun rises with scorching heat & withers the plant; its beauty is destroyed.” *James 1:11* Certain risk factors for heat related illnesses dictate a person's exposure to the sun's heat & participation in physical activity. Factors include: age (specifically those elderly or under 5 years), chronic, respiratory or cardiovascular diseases, obesity, pregnancy, alcohol consumption, athletics, military activity, outdoor occupations & performances. Some medications such as tranquilizers, antihistamines, antibiotics, antidepressants, beta-blockers, & some sleeping pills interfere with the body's cooling mechanisms, putting people at risk. Consider your risks when deciding how much time to spend in the sun.
