## Health News - Health Ministry



“They will neither hunger nor thirst, nor will the desert heat or sun beat upon them. He who has compassion on them will guide them & lead them beside springs of water.” *Isaiah 49:10* Sunstroke or heat exhaustion can happen quickly & without any warning. It is dangerous for all ages, but especially the young & old since their bodies can't control temperature as well as other ages. During activity & heat, the body continually loses water as it cools itself down, but doesn't register thirst until the stores of fluid have been greatly diminished. Because of this anyone in the heat must drink water throughout their activity or work. When thirst occurs, it is too late & the body has difficulty catching up. Be prepared: drink water & avoid serious heat illness.
