Health News - Health Ministry



One diet does not fit all. Men & women have different nutritional needs & body types. Up to about age 10 caloric needs are about the same, but puberty triggers change. Adult men usually have less body fat & 10 to 20% more muscle than women. This is why men's energy needs & appetites are bigger. Moderately active men usually need 2000 to 2800 calories per day. Energy needs depend on height, weight, & activity level. For energy, weight management & disease prevention eat whole grains like whole-grain bread, pasta, cereal, brown rice, oats, barley, fruits, & vegetables. These foods are high in fiber, help manage hunger & fullness, & help fend off certain cancers such as colon & prostate.
