Health News - Health Ministry



Food Labels: People who read food labels have healthier diets than those who don't, a new study shows.

- 61.6% read nutrition facts panels
- 51.6% look at the list of ingredients
- 47.2% read the serving size
- 43.8% review the health claims at least some of the time when making buying decisions.

Significant differences were found between label & non-label readers in their intake of total calories, total fat, saturated fat, cholesterol, sodium, dietary fiber & sugars. The food label alone is not enough to change behavior, but it can be a valuable tool in combating obesity & many chronic diseases.
